Our Daily Routine

Mrs Evans will teach on Mondays and Tuesdays and Mrs Richards on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. The children will continue to be settled into class from 8.50am with their busy fingers activity. Please continue to ensure your child brings a water bottle and their book bag with reading book and high frequency words to school each day. The children continue to have a coloured button to sit on in class called our carpet space and will have new learning partners this term.

PSED - Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will continue to visit Moreton Court every other Monday. This has been a fantastic opportunity for the children and one which we are keen to continue. We will start again on Monday 13th January. We will be taking part in a daily Relax Kids session straight after lunch. This will give the children a time to relax, re focus and be ready for our afternoon activities.

Communication and Language and Literacy

The children will continue to read at least twice a week to an adult in class. Some children are now reading every day to help them with their reading and we will continue to practise high frequency words at school and give out new ones. Please continue to read at home with your child and write in their reading record when you do so. This helps us keep on top of how often a book has been read.

Physical Development

The children will need to come to school in their Outdoor Learning clothes on Thursdays and will change into their P.E kits after lunch. These can stay on pegs at the beginning of the week if necessary. We have now introduced our daily teeth cleaning routine after each lunch time.

Maths

Our focus to start the term is exploring shape. We will then move on to number bonds and doubling and halving.

Knowledge and Understanding

We will be learning about China and Chinese New Year (if you have any artefacts they will be gratefully received). The children will also be exploring the Learn Pads and will be creating 'Top Tips' to help them when doing so.

Show and Tell

This will be on a Monday each week and will be 4 children. Please can you encourage your child to bring in certificate of achievement or something of special interest to them.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be exploring a Chinese New Year role play area, environmental sounds and rhythm and will be colour mixing.
