Mrs Becky Beer works with Butterflies Monday to Wednesday and Miss Sarah Turner works with Butterflies Thursdays and Fridays.

Miss Nikki Troke and Miss Julie Williams work with the Sunflowers every day between 9am – 1pm. Nikki works with Sunflowers in the afternoon.

Mrs Alice Harries, Miss Chloe Mayne and Miss Anela Butler work with Caterpillars. We would like to welcome Miss Anela Butler to our team - she will be with us while Mrs Baker is on maternity leave.

Please ensure that the children have coats, full waterproofs, wellies and a change of clothes in school every day. They will also need to bring their book bag and a named water bottle into school every day. Please put a keyring on your child's book bag so that it is easy to identify - it is important that your child can recognise their own belongings. Please make sure that books are in book bags every day. We are working hard to promote independence and would ask that you are mindful when preparing packed lunches. Will your child be able to access their packed lunches and clear up independently? We are always on hand to help if needed.

All children in Caterpillars and Butterflies take part in a PE lesson on a Monday. Please make sure that Caterpillars and Butterflies come into school wearing their PE kit – please see the parent information booklet for further information regarding uniform:

Butterflies and Caterpillars take part in outdoor learning on a Thursday afternoon, Caterpillars will have an additional session on a Tuesday morning which will take place until October half term. Please make sure that children wear their PE kit with a plain long sleeved top underneath. They will need full waterproofs and wellies - named please.

Snacks - all children in Caterpillars and Butterflies are provided with a fresh fruit snack and milk. This is normally apples, bananas, carrots or tomatoes. If you would like to send your child in with a different fresh fruit snack please feel free. Sunflowers need to provide their own. We are asking for a snack donation - a packet of savoury snacks - crackers, breadsticks, rice cakes (not chocolate topped - due to allergies) per child which will be shared with your child's friends to supplement the fruit snack.

The Morning Routine - We ask that you drop off your child and collect them from the front school gate. Nikki and Alice will be meeting the children at the gate. Children who are new

to Caterpillars will be supported to take their belongings to the conservatory, where they will be greeted by Anela. The children will then play in the conservatory to help them settle into the morning.

Communication - your child's keyworker (you will have received a Dojo message informing you of who this is) is your initial port of call. They are contactable via dojo and will catch up with you at the end of the session, when possible. Nikki and Alice will happily pass any messages onto them. If you have any questions please initially direct them to your child's keyworker. Mrs Emptage and Mrs Hinchliffe are the keyworkers for all of the Butterflies. Please be assured that you can contact Mrs Emptage or Mrs Hinchliffe at any time - this applies to parents of children in all groups.

On a Monday, we will communicate the story and song of the week via dojo. During the week, your child's keyworker will post at least one Wow moment to your child's portfolio. Butterflies will be learning how to post their own work. On a Friday there will be a summary of the learning from the week posted on Dojo, to our FSU Facebook page and on the school website.
