- Listen to simple stories
- Develop pretend play
- Understand simple instructions 'give to Mummy'
- Identify familiar objects when described 'blue car' 'shiny apple'

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Be increasingly able to talk about and manage their feelings
- Develop friendships with other children
- Safely explore emotions within play and stories
- Talk about feelings further 'I am sad because....'
 'I love it when'

Physical Development

- Build independently with range of resources
- Sit on a push along wheeled toy, use a scooter or ride a tricycle
- Start eating independently and learn how to use knife and fork

Literacy

- Enjoy sharing books with an adult
- Develop play around favourite stories and using props

Ask questions about the book, make comments and share ideas

Expressive Arts and Design

- Move and dance to music
- Show attention to sounds and music
- Make simple models which express their ideas
- Develop pretend play, pretending one object represents another

Mathematics

- Combine objects like stacking blocks and cups. Put objects inside others and take them out again.
- Complete inset puzzles
- Build with a range of resources

Understanding the World

- Repeat actions that have an effect
- Explore materials with different properties
