

Sport Premium Funding Action Plan 2016/17

Monkleigh Primary, like all primary schools, receives Sports Premium Funding from the government. The funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. The amount of funding is based on a lump sum plus extra per child on roll.

How we plan to spend the funding:

PE subject leader time	£500

Time to shine project – visits to pupils individual chosen sports clubs	£500
Continuing with the very successful active lunchtime play	£500
Supporting top up swimming	£500
Hire of village hall for table tennis club and indoor PE sessions for dance/gym (as school does not have a hall)	£200
Flags/ pennants for building team spirit	£200
Whole school tennis sessions with coach at Atlantic racquet centre	£500
Sports week – visiting coaches offering sessions in news sports for children and parents, and healthy breakfast	£1500
Hosting inter sports multi skills festival and cross country competition	£250
Mini bus hire	£1000
Develop outside area for forest schools and OOA	£500
Pedpass subscription	£250
Purchase of additional learn pads for use in PE/outdoor learning for assessment and evidence gathering, for children to record each other and feed back on skills seen. For teachers to demonstrate good practice to improve skills. Purchase of white board to display information gathered and share with class.	£2000
